Nov. 14, 1945

Dearest Mother,

I'm out of the bus now back with the troops. I rode the train down from Tokyo, got on at 8:30 this morning & got here at 1:00 this afternoon. I never had such a ride trying to find a place for there very few here can speak English and if you don't know where the train runs, well you guess half what they are trying to tell you to get on train if you are right you get there, if not take another train at the next station.

Glad you like your work where you are hope you don't work so hard, and mom don't worry about me ~~or~~ or anyone else for that want help things one bit what's done is done and what happens you can't help by worrying. and as for me ~~and~~ you don't need to worry about for I will make out okay. I guess the reason I don't worry about much is because I'm not old enough to stop and think. some thing happens here or goes wrong I forget about it the next day and reason it probably don't matter in the

army if it doesn't concern yourself. you  
just think about yourself and the other fellows  
have the same in most cases not always.

No 2 haven't wrote to Dad yet don't know  
whether I will or not send he didn't ever ask  
about me I will just wait a while and maybe he  
will be glad to hear from me then. if he doesn't  
feel like that I'm over here I will just wait until  
I see him which I hope to see some day.

We are doing ~~the~~ M. P. Duty here in  
Yakohama area. This is the station name where  
we are located at Sugita if it mean anything  
I haven't been able to find out but I guess it does  
we are near the Yakosuka Naval Base you  
might hear that in the news or see it in the papers.  
What Betty Lee want to marry a Guy that she never  
saw and don't know any thing about. well that  
not my business, but I have seen a lot better  
guys in lots of ways. He is one of those guys  
that went AWOL from the line where men  
was needed at one time. you don't need to  
tell her for she will tell him & I might  
see him some day & don't want any trouble  
from him. He is from Fort Smith.

I'm not working too hard but I don't like  
you any better than Glenn does I don't  
think. What kind of an outfit is he in  
do you have his address.

Say hello to every one that ask about  
me & I hope I can do that my self in the  
near future

I got a letter from Mary & Ann each and  
one from Virginia, you don't know her  
though. I will love for now
