

S T A T E M E N T

Inasmuch as the unexpired portion of term of service is less than the remaining requirement prescribed for selection for and/or to complete the normal overseas tour of the area to which assigned I have counselled SGM E9 Lester Edgar, RA 38 506 482, Headquarters USACDCEC, Ft Ord, California this date, 16 December 66, 1000 hours. Individual hereby request that he be released from this assignment as it is his intention not to reenlist or amend and/or extend his current term of service.

Individual understands that the release from this specific assignment makes him ineligible to reenlist for a period of 93 days after discharge. Further, he is fully aware that by declining to reenlist or amending and/or extending his current term of service, he will immediately be subject to an overseas assignment to an area for which he presently has sufficient time remaining for the prescribed tour, or to any other area at the discretion of the Department of the Army. In addition, he is aware that completing such an assignment will not serve to restore reenlistment rights lost as a result of this declination.
