Your retirement processing will consist of the following:

1. Report to Transfer Point, Bldg-2335, at 1100 Hours JUN 12 for records processing and interview. BRING YOUR HEALTH AND DENTAL RECORDS.
2. Any time on or after JUN 15 report to Central Clearance, Bldg 2356, upstairs, and initiate Installation Clearance. Keep in mind you are not cleared until you return the completed clearance form to Central Clearance.
3. As soon as possible after receipt of these instructions, proceed to the ID Branch, Bldg 2336, to have a picture taken for your Retired ID Card. Since your dependents will also have to obtain a new Privilege Card, it would be advisable to have them accompany you to have their picture taken. The earlier this is accomplished the more assurance you will have of obtaining the new cards on date of retirement. THE ID BRANCH IS OPEN FOR ABOVE PROCESSING FROM 1230 TO 1630 HRS AND ON SATURDAY MORNINGS ONLY.
4. Individuals living in Government Quarters are encouraged to clear such quarters at least 48 hours prior to retirement. Report to the Family Housing Office to make necessary arrangements.
5. Report to Transfer Point, at 0900 hours, JUN 30, Bldg 2335, in Class "A" Uniform or appropriate civilian attire. Have your ID Card and Dependents Privilege Cards in your possession.
 - a. At 0900 hours, the Adjutant General of Fort Ord will present you with your retirement certificate.
 - b. Old ID Cards will be turned in and your Retired ID Cards will be issued.
 - c. Retirees who requested their final pay in cash or check pick-up from Finance will proceed to Cashier, Bldg 2437. All others are free to depart Fort Ord at their convenience.
