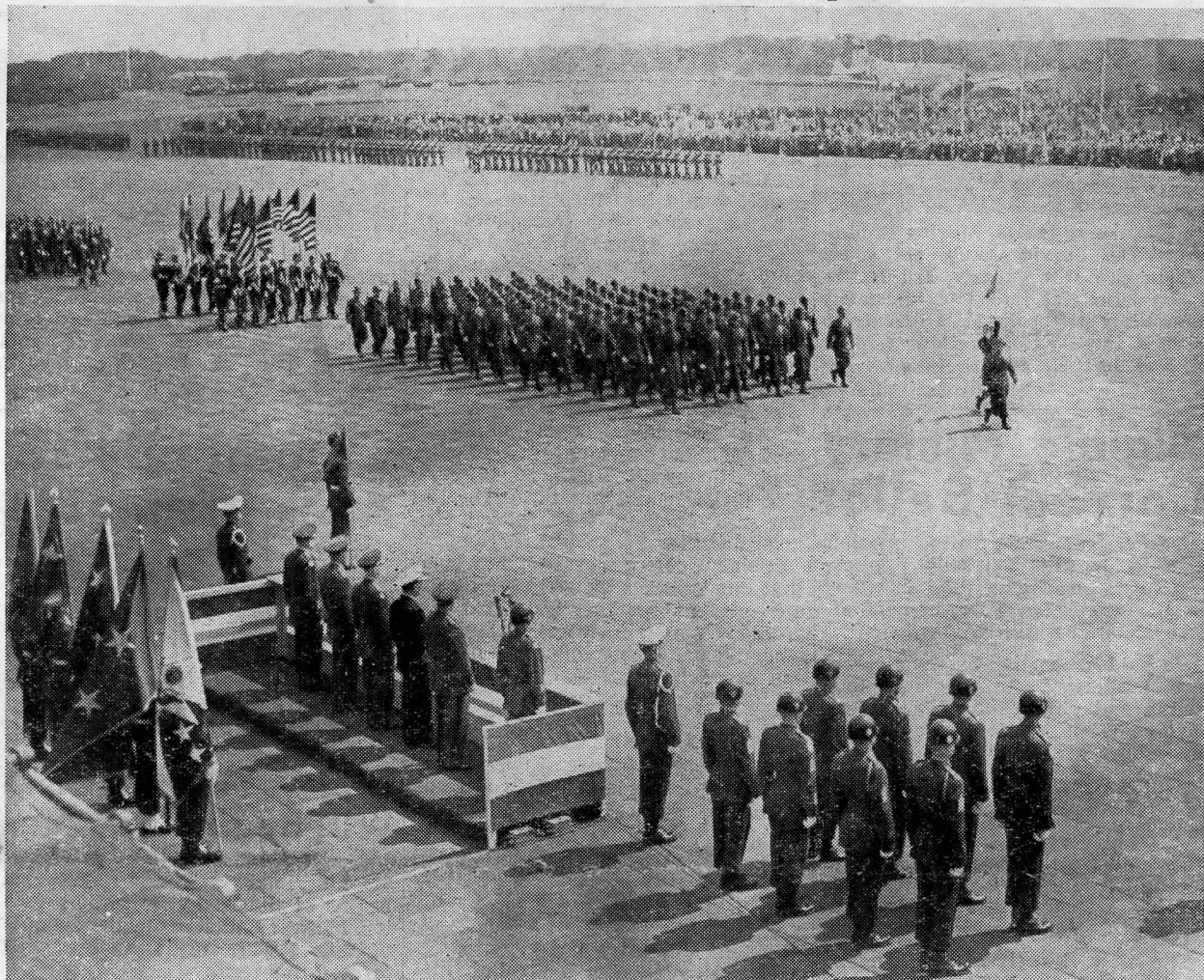


...Precision-Sharp



TROOPS PASS IN REVIEW—Headquarters Company, Special Troops, augmented by Signal personnel and commanded by Captain Ronald J.
